Decision by The Chairperson of the Expert Committee on the Industrial Heritage including Operative Properties.

July 3, 2012

The Expert Committee on the Industrial Heritage including Operative Properties shall be operated in accordance with the "Establishment----Operative Properties" (decision by the Chief Cabinet Secretary) as well as rules described in this paper.

- 1. Task of The Chairperson
- The Chairperson shall coordinate discussions among members to build a consensus on matters regarding No.3 in the decision by the Chief Cabinet Secretary.
- 2. Deputy Chairperson
- The Deputy Chairperson shall be designated by The Chairperson among the members of the Expert Committee.
- The Deputy Chairperson shall take over the role of The Chairperson in cases of The Chairperson's accident.
- 3. Attendance at the meeting
- The committee meeting shall, in principle, be made open to the public. Outline of the discussion at the meeting shall be made in public after the meeting.
- The Chairperson can make a decision to make a part of, or all the meeting not open to the public, and to make a part of, or all outline of the discussion not in public, in cases The Chairperson assumes that it is better for avoiding trouble.
- 4. Distributed papers
- Papers distributed at meetings shall, in principle, be made in public.
- The Chairperson can make a part of, or all distributed papers not in public, in cases
 The Chairperson assumes that it is better for avoiding trouble.
