III. Smooth preparations for and operation of Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai

- Ensuring participation and exhibitions by various nations and international organizations through such actions as participation invitation activities, participation support, and smooth procedures for entering and exiting the country
- Ensuring security and safety in such ways as counter terrorism, cybersecurity measures, disaster prevention and mitigation measures, infection control measures, countermeasures against heat and prevention of food poisoning
- Safe, smooth transport of visitors and event personnel through such measures as strengthening transport infrastructure such as railways, roads, air routes, and sea routes.
- Improvement of the infrastructure in the area around the site such as improving access to the venue and improving safety in the region
- **<u>Preparation in line with the philosophy of universal design</u> in both tangible and intangible elements**
- <u>Respond to environmental issues</u> through the use of renewable energy and hydrogen, distributed energy resources, and energy conservation and green technologies as well as the promotion of the "3Rs" (reduce, reuse and recycle)
- **Building and using ICT systems** in ways such as combining physical space and cyberspace
- Improvements for welcoming foreign visitors, in ways such as strengthening the CIQ system (customs, immigration management, quarantine systems) for people and objects, and strengthening multilingual support.
- <u>Creating the Expo 2025 momentum through every chance</u> in ways such as using international conferences and educational institutions and by various major constituents holding related events concurrently with Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai
- Issue a commemorative postcard/stamp with included donations, issue commemorative license plates, and sponsored races by betting and gambling services will be held.
