- 1. The investigation should be conducted based on my approach
- Considering the responsibility to our descendants, the final report needs to be capable of standing up to critical evaluation even 100 years later
- 3. Answer questions of the Japanese public
- 4. Answer questions of the people around the world
- 5. Pursuing individual responsibility is not our objective
- 6. Accurately grasp what happened during the accident
- 7. Understand the background of the accident
- 8. Replicate experiments and preserving the accident in dynamic condition are essential

Together with the other members and technical advisors of the Committee, I would like to make every effort to thoroughly clarify the cause of this unprecedented accident, including its background, and obtain useful lessons for future generations.
