Establishment of an Expert Panel on Climate Change

March 25, 2021 Global Warming Prevention Headquarters' Decision

1. Intent and Purpose

Taking into consideration that a series of international conferences such as COP26 in November are to be held, the "Expert Panel on Climate Change" is established under the Global Warming Prevention Headquarters in order to discuss on climate change in a cross-sectoral manner and consider policy directions to realize a green society from the perspective of a positive cycle of economic growth and environmental protection.

2. Organization

- (1) The Panel is comprised of the experts listed in the annex and hosted by the Prime Minister.
- (2) The Chairperson of the Panel is mutually chosen by members.
- (3) The Panel may request the attendance of relevant Ministers and others if needed.
- 3. General affairs of the Panel are handled by the Cabinet Secretariat.
