

Holding of a Meeting of the Advisory Committee on National Resilience (Disaster Reduction and Mitigation)

February 22, 2013
Decision of the Chief Cabinet Secretary

1. Purport

A meeting of the Advisory Committee on National Resilience (hereinafter referred to as the “Advisory Committee”) shall be held in order to hear experts’ opinions on how to promote comprehensive measures for building national resilience with the aim of creating a strong and flexible country, from the perspective of disaster reduction and mitigation, for the purpose of protecting people’s lives and property by any means.

2. Structure

- (1) The Advisory Committee shall consist of the members as listed in the Attachment and its meetings shall be held by the Minister in charge of Building National Resilience.
- (2) The Minister in charge of Building National Resilience shall select one person from among those listed in the Attachment and ask him/her to chair the Advisory Committee.
- (3) The Advisory Committee may request the attendance of other related persons as necessary.

3. Other

Affairs of the Advisory Committee are to be handled by the Cabinet Secretariat.
